The volunteer project is different this academic year compared to other years. We are having a smaller group with not only university students, but also high school students involved. Beside that, the personal program of the volunteers doesn't allow them to be very flexible, which makes it very difficult to run the activities with the children in the same organized way as we were used to do it.




We decided that until February 2017 we'll do occasional activities not only with the new volunteers, but also with the people that are available: old volunteers and friends. In this way those that subscribed this year will attend when they are free. We also hope that by that time everyone will figure out how much time they can invest into this.

So till now we met the children several times and we offered training to the new volunteers. On the Saint's Nicholas holiday (6th of December) we organized a special meeting with games and

presents for the kids at *Ciresarii* (at-risk children's home). The largest event though was a field trip to *Ferma animalelor* in Bucharest. The group was made of thirty-one children (of which twenty-one with disabilities) and almost thirty volunteers. The kids were happy even though the weather was quite cold. We looked at and fed farm animals, we observed how to milk a cow (a new thing for most of them), and we had lunch together at the farm's restaurant. This week is the last one before the holidays in which we'll have some activities.




Besides the activities with the children we organized creative workshops in a high school in our town. We especially made Christmas decorations with them and Christmas cards for their teachers.
