### MINISTRY NEWS

#### THEOLOGICAL SEMINARS

God used two of the seminary courses in a very special way! Some students who successfully completed the *Marriage and Family* course registered to attend the class again by auditing it for their personal benefit. This rarely happens in the Czech Republic! AND – after completing *The Role of Fathers*, many students sent personal emails for after the class ended as they dealt with the issues stirred up by the class.

#### **PASTORAL CARE**

Because there are gifted servants who seem to draw those with struggles, a need exists for these servants to be encouraged and supported as they cultivate their gifts. In a family style environment, Pavel was blessed to equip a small group of these servants through the sharing of experiences and discussion on the best interventions for problems they encounter.



The positive and negative roles of family in the formation of functional and dysfunctional patterns was discussed in depth. It was a joy to see the movement from theological information to personal stories as involved and attentive participants listened and supported one another.

#### **EVANGELICAL SEMINARS**

Churches across the country are now frequently hosting evangelistic seminars on relationships. Because relationships are important to everyone,
