### **OCTOBER 2022**

Because there is a possibility of encountering dangerous situations, an emergency service worker was invited to the lyceum. He taught our pupils how to act during a fire, an air raid, during a radiation explosion and explained the rules of behavior in a shelter.



On the occasion of Defender Day in Ukraine, a meeting with Andriy Tyurenkov, a military of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, took place in our lyceum. The students listened with great admiration to the chaplain, who spoke about the heroic deeds and courage of our defenders at the front. The children were not only listeners, but also actively participated in the conversation, asked many questions and were able to get answers about the real life of soldiers in such difficult conditions. Andriy paid special attention to the stories about the preaching of the Gospel to soldiers at the front and their spiritual support. .



Lyceum students and their parents show a great desire to help our soldiers. In October, a fair was held in support of the Armed Forces. The children willingly brought various hand-made sweets and bakery. Everyone who wanted to was able to buy goodies, and the collected funds were given to volunteers who provide for the needs of the militaries at the front.



A good tradition in our lyceum is the celebration of "Thanksgiving Day" at the end of October. Each class presented a poster about their school time. At the celebration, the students were invited to tell what they thank God for in the life of the lyceum.



The most precious gift we have received from God, for which we should be thankful, is salvation through Jesus Christ. Therefore, every year, the teachers who are volunteers of the "Samaritan's Purse" mission organize evangelistic lessons for all lyceum students. On it, the students learn about the plan of salvation, what repentance is, how the living faith in Jesus Christ is manifested. After that, the students receive gifts from the mission.



Teachers try to encourage students with trips and excursions, when it is possible. In October, there were excursions for the history of Ukraine course. Also, students of grades 7-9 had the opportunity to go to the Carpathian mountains for 2 days. It was an exciting trip that unites students, develops friendly relations in the team.



## **NOVEMBER 2022**

November was not easy for us. Due to the increased aggression from Russia and the threat of rocket attacks, we often had to go down to the shelter together with the students. Children find positivity even in these difficult circumstances. Because this is a good opportunity to communicate with each other, to eat goodies together.

We have started a good tradition in the shelter during an air raid, together with the pastor we read the Bible and pray for God's protection and protection of the Armed Forces and the people of Ukraine



As a result of frequent rocket attacks throughout the territory of Ukraine, problems with electricity have arisen, but we are learning to find a way out of the situation. Canteen workers sometimes prepare lunch in the open air to feed all students and employees. Now we are looking for opportunities for alternative sources of light, so that our pupils have a stable and high-quality education in this unstable and difficult time for Ukraine.
