When a lot of people and friends around us are fleeing the country, God reminds us of His word that we are here for these people, not for ourselves. And God is able to make us a house of bread for the people here, we believe both spiritually and physically.

A lot has happened over the year, but the most inspiring thing is how God made the impossible possible, turned dreams into reality, and our plans were approved by Him and fulfilled together with Him.

Evangelism, Bible school students, new house churches, gypsies baptized, women’s conferences and seminars, pregnancy school, widows’ camp, teen girls’ camp, youth and teen summer camps, feeding and ministering to the homeless, visits to nursing homes, orphanages - all this was able to take place thanks to your support, your prayers, God’s help and intervention, and our obedience. Praise Jesus for this favorable time for the salvation of people.
